

FIRST-AID

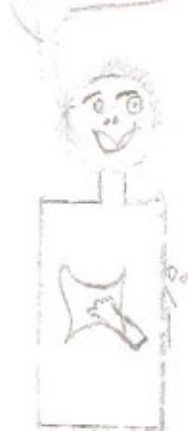


Dear Hugh,
